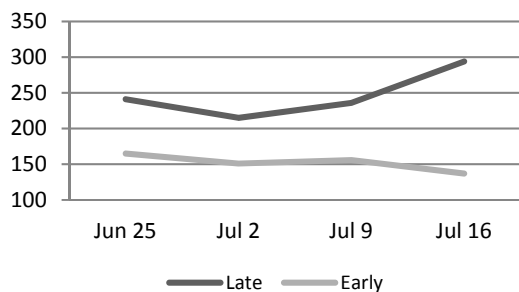

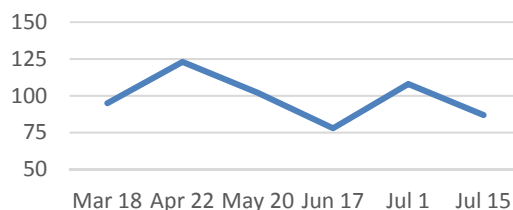

### Sunday Worship Attendance



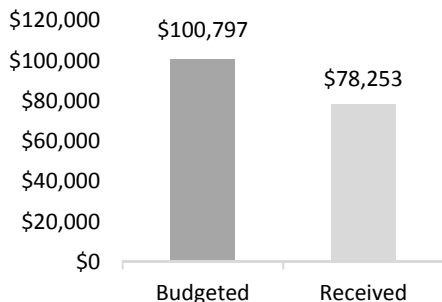

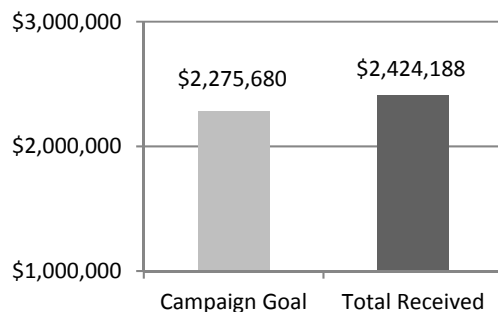
