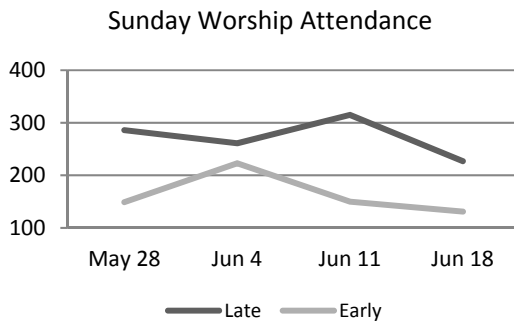

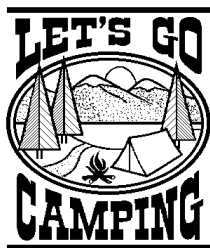


WHAT IS LUTHERAN EARLY RESPONSE TEAM (LERT)?
