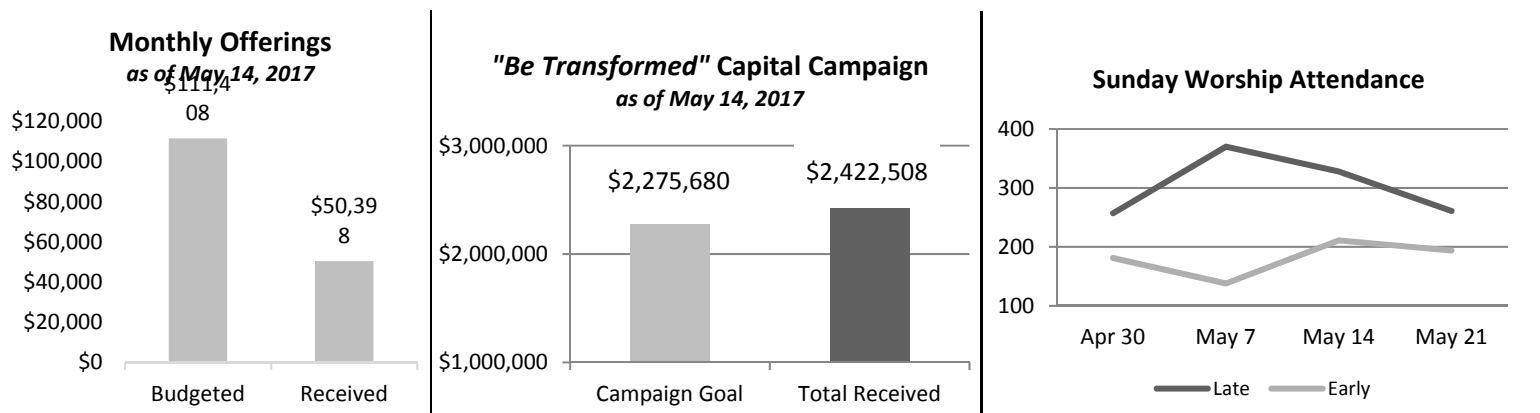
Help us conserve our resources. Please drop your bulletin in the **paper only recycle bin** at the door as you exit the Sanctuary.

SUMMER BIBLE STUDY -- A MAN NAMED MARTIN

BEGINNING SUNDAY, JUNE 4TH – CLASSROOM A/B

A Man Named Martin -- This Bible study from Lutheran Men's Network is devoted to Martin Luther -- a monk whose Spirit-inspired grasp of God's justification of sinners through faith in the Savior was the cornerstone of the Protestant Reformation. In this study, Luther's life and times are examined through the lens of history, religion and theology. We examine the errant teachings and wayward traditions of the Late Medieval Church that eventually sparked the Protestant Reformation, a theological overhaul set in motion most notably by Martin Luther's nailing of the 95 Theses to the church door at Wittenberg. A Man Named Martin is a fresh and explorative look at an individual who, down through the centuries, has increased in importance and vitality to the Christian church. Instructor: Bill Sczepanski

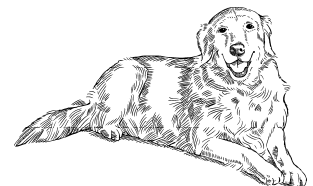
