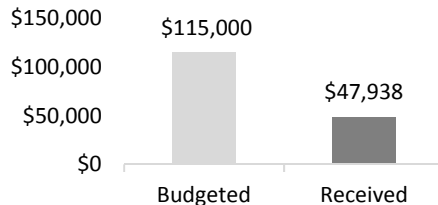
### Sunday Worship Attendance



### Contemporary Worship Attendance

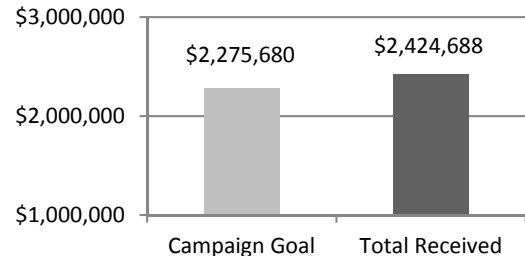

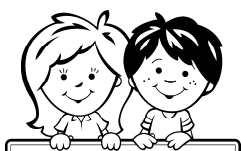


### LOG REFORMATION T-SHIRT YOUTH MINISTRY FUNDRAISER

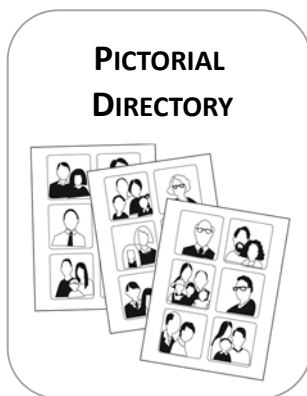
### HEARING/VISION SCREENER VOLUNTEERS NEEDED
